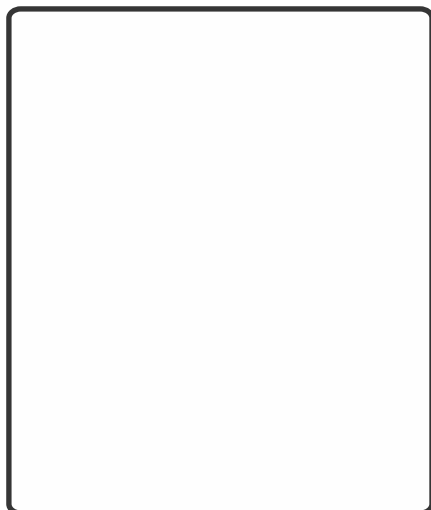


ACTIVITY 10: AN ELDERLY LOCAL PERSON

1. For children to interview an elderly person it needs to be very sensitively undertaken. Depending on circumstances, permission to interview may have to be obtained from family or carers and a prepared list of questions should be submitted when seeking permission.
